


FORMAT

Our Shows:

- Are for the family, and suitable for children aged 5+.
- Are built around action-packed performances from professional actors, classic storytelling techniques, new music and participation.
- Include an activity pack that can be sold or given away, depending on our arrangement with the venue, which has fun creative writing, drawing, and imagination exercises for our audiences to do after the show.
- Cultivate young people's empathy and reasoning skills.
- Encourage young people to express themselves.
- Encourage young people and their adults to contribute to a creative community built around the show.
- Require just 3hrs Get in & 2hrs Get Out.
- Have been curated by professionals with over 15 years experience in the field.

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
